

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

**\* What is ASB?**

Associated Student Body is a group of students that plan and run student-based activities.

**\* What does the ASB card get me?**

Discounts on event tickets, yearbook purchase, spirit wear and much more.

**\* Why should I donate to the library or emergency fund?**

With funding cuts, all extra spending on books and emergency supplies for your children depends on donations.

**\* When do I get my P.E. clothes?**

P.E. clothes are distributed during P.E. class, approximately the second week of school.

**\* When do I get my schedule?**

On the first day of school, students will report to a room, which is assigned by their last name. Schedules will be given out, and students will then report to their 1<sup>st</sup> period class.

Supervision begins at 8:00 a.m. Students are allowed through the gates at 8:15 a.m.
